Treasurer's Report:

BO does not yet have a Treasurer's report as he has just returned.

Old Business:

CB will be following up with Crandall regarding the feasibility of purchasing Kanopy (video streaming service).

We are waiting to hear from the architect Mark Thaler, who was supposed to be at this meeting but CB was unable to reach him prior to the meeting.

The rugs in the entranceway are being changed at a more regular basis.

New Business:

The SALS Annual meeting will be held on May 20th. Unfortunately several people are out of town on that date.

BO made a motion to add monies to whatever The Friends pay toward the Better Reader program to bring the total up to \$2000 from the Cambridge Public Library. JBP seconded. All were in favor.

CB will be taking a course to become a certified notary. KG made a motion to pay for the expenditure of \$65 for certification to be refunded by SALS upon completion of the course. BO seconded. All were in favor.

SM asked for suggestions regarding the excess of books that are in the basement. CB suggested boxing the books and having a "pay what you will" sale in the upcoming months.

Library Director Report:

We had our first "Thursday Night Live" with Whitman's Feed. It was highly attended. They will be bringing a new animal every month on the last Thursday of the month from 4-5:00. On 4/25 they will be bringing in ferrets.

This Saturday from 10:30-12:00 Howard Romack will be doing "Leaf Lessons" regarding photosynthesis and discuss why leaves change colors and fall off in the winter. He is also bringing in pressed leaves to make mounts. The Village wide clean-up
